- Worsted weight yarn in two colors (approximately 200 yards of each color)
- Size H (5.0mm) crochet hook

- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Gauge

4 stitches and 4 rows per inch in single crochet

Instructions

Round 1: With the main color yarn, make a magic ring. Single crochet (sc) 6 times into the ring. Pull the ring closed to join. (6 stitches)

Round 2: Sc 2 in each stitch around. (12 stitches)

Round 3: Sc 1 in the first stitch, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (18 stitches)

Round 4: Sc 1 in each of the next 2 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (24 stitches)

Round 5: Sc 1 in each of the next 3 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (30 stitches)

Round 6: Sc 1 in each of the next 4 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (36 stitches)

Round 7: Sc 1 in each of the next 5 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (42 stitches)

Round 8: Sc 1 in each of the next 6 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (48 stitches)

Round 9: Sc 1 in each of the next 7 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (54 stitches)

Round 10: Sc 1 in each of the next 8 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (60 stitches)

Round 11: Sc 1 in each of the next 9 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (66 stitches)

Round 12: Sc 1 in each of the next 10 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (72 stitches)

Round 13: Sc 1 in each of the next 11 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (78 stitches)

Round 14: Sc 1 in each of the next 12 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (84 stitches)

Round 15: Sc 1 in each of the next 13 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (90 stitches)

Round 16: Sc 1 in each of the next 14 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (96 stitches)

Round 17: Change to the accent color yarn. Sc 1 in each of the next 15 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (102 stitches)

Round 18: Sc 1 in each of the next 16 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (108 stitches)

Round 19: Sc 1 in each of the next 17 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (114 stitches)

Round 20: Sc 1 in each of the next 18 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (120 stitches)

Round 21: Sc 1 in each of the next 19 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (126 stitches)

Round 22: Sc 1 in each of the next 20 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (132 stitches)

Round 23: Change back to the main color yarn. Sc 1 in each stitch around. (132 stitches)

Round 24: Sc 1 in each of the next 2 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (138 stitches)

Round 25: Sc 1 in each of the next 3 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (144 stitches)

Round 26: Sc 1 in each of the next 4 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (150 stitches)

Round 27: Sc 1 in each of the next 5 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (156 stitches)

Round 28: Sc 1 in each of the next 6 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (162 stitches)

Round 29: Sc 1 in each of the next 7 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (168 stitches)

Round 30: Sc 1 in each of the next 8 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (174 stitches)

Round 31: Sc 1 in each of the next 9 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (180 stitches)

Round 32: Sc 1 in each of the next 10 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (186 stitches)

Round 33: Sc 1 in each of the next 11 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (192 stitches)

Round 34: Sc 1 in each of the next 12 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (198 stitches)

Round 35: Sc 1 in each of the next 13 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (204 stitches)

Round 36: Sc 1 in each of the next 14 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (210 stitches)

Round 37: Sc 1 in each of the next 15 stitches, sc 2 in the next stitch. Repeat around. (216 stitches)

Round 38: Sc 1 in each stitch around. (216 stitches)

Round 39: Sc 1 in each of the next 2 stitches, sc 2 together. Repeat around. (180 stitches)

Round 40: Sc 1 in each of the next



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
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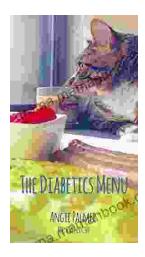
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
